



VPK Provider Performance Metric & Designation



Composite Score: "Composite Program Assessment Score" means an average of all Division of Early Learning-adopted program assessment dimension scores from VPK classrooms. Each range (ex. 4.00 - 4.49) receives a value (ex. 5).

Achievement: A value derived from a percentage of "Eligible Children" (Children who attended 50% or more of a VPK year's hours at the provider) based on how many of the children met or exceeded the new "Kindergarten Readiness" score of 707 on Progress Monitoring 3 [PM3]

Learning Gains: A value derived from a percentage of "Eligible Children" (Children who attended 50% or more of a VPK year's hours at the provider) based on each eligible child's rate of growth shown between the PM1 score and PM3 score modified by the number of calendar days between the two testing dates. And children who consistently scored in the "Highest Literacy Classification" (852+ in PM1 & PM3)

Dear Parent or Guardian of Emily Albert:

Emily has taken a Star Early Literacy assessment on the computer. Star Early Literacy measures your child's proficiency in up to nine areas that are important in reading development. As with any assessment, many factors can affect your child's scores. It is important to understand that these scores provide only one picture of how your child is doing in school.

Scaled Score

The Scaled Score is your child's overall score, calculated based on both the difficulty of the questions and the number of correct responses. Scaled Scores in Star Early Liberacy in the Unified scale range from 200 to 1300 and span the grades Pre-K. through 3.



Emily's skills are higher than 41% of students nationally in the same grade. This score is at average. The PR Range indicates that, if Emily had taken the Star Early Literacy test many times, most of his/her scores would likely have been between 24-41.

Scaled Scores relate to four developmental stages: Early Emergent Reader (200 - 682), Late Emergent Reader (663 - 785), Transitional Reader (786-851), and Probable Reader (852 - 1100). A Scaled Score of 644 means that Emily is at the Early Emergent Reader stage.


Children at the Early Emergent Reader stage are beginning to understand that printed text has meaning. They are learning that reading involves printed words and sentences, and that print flows from left to right and from the top to the bottom of the page. They are also beginning to identify colors, shapes, numbers, and letters.


At this stage, Emily may know that spoken speech can be represented by letters and that letters have specific shapes. He/She is likely to be able to identify the letters and to see the differences between them. Also, Emily may begin to recognize rhyming sounds.

The most important thing you can do to encourage your child's growth in emergent reading skills is to read storybooks aloud to Emily at home. If your child asks for the same book again and again, go right on reading it. Also, talk with Emily about what you've read. Through listening to and talking about stories, Emily will learn to relate spoken words with printed words on the page.






For the custom dates, its best to use the arrows verses punching in the dates, after the dates have been selected, press Apply. Down at the bottom of the screen is **UPDATE REPORT**. This will give you a report for the whole class.

Scroll back to the top of the screen press the PDF tab, it will allow you to select the current PDF for the whole class, or PDF of individual student reports. Select the view PDF (blue tab). This PDF will show all the students along with where they have scored on the benchmarks.



Classroom Report




You can also select the PDF of individual students. This report is great for identifying where the student needs intervention. You can plan your small group times around what they children need according to this report.






